As a member of the Board of Director at Cirque Corporation, a developer and manufacture of touch pad technology used in computers and handheld mobile devices, he was asked by the board to become the President and CEO to enhance the companies market position for a for an exit strategy for the shareholders. A successful merger with one of Cirque's strategic partners exceeded shareholders expectations. In these capacities he has had extensive experience with sales, marketing, manufacturing, foreign operations, strategic and operational planning, joint ventures and strategic alliances. This experience has also contributed as a Board of Trustee for the Utah Information Technology Association (UITA) and as Co-President of the Minnesota Chapter of the American Electronic Association (AEA).
